Fr. James Dominic Brent, O.P., was born and raised in Michigan. He pursued his undergraduate and graduate studies in Philosophy and completed his doctorate in Philosophy at Saint Louis University. In 2004, he entered the Dominican Order and completed his theological studies at the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, DC. In 2010, he was ordained a priest. He has taught on the faculty at The Catholic University of America. He has traveled the country as an itinerant preacher on college campuses. He currently teaches Dominicans in formation for the priesthood at the Dominican House of Studies, and he continues to lead weekend retreats for college students and young adults.
